Social Distancing Guidelines

For the safety of our guests and our team members, we would like everyone to follow these guidelines as it is important in creating a safe socially-distanced environment for you and others.

These guidelines follow the professional advice of our national health leaders and of TDLR.

Failure to follow will result in refusal of service.

- 1. Everyone is required to wear a facemask. No mask = No entry. You must keep your facemask on for your duration of your visit.**
- 2. Depending on space/availability, we would like to ask all of our guest who are not immediately seated to wait in their cars or nearby areas to prevent any unexpected clusters of people in any one designated area of our establishment.**
- 3. Everyone must wash their hands before beginning a service. *We are methodically cleaning and disinfecting throughout the day, we want all areas of our establishment to be as unexposed as possible. Minimum of 20 seconds, warm water with soap.***
- 4. We will be working on an appointment based system. Walk-ins are welcomed, but may have to be accommodated for a later time based on space/availability *(We are required by law to minimize the occupancy of those in our establishment).***
- 5. Our bar will not be serving any drinks, we want to prevent all potential room for cross contamination. *Accommodations can be made, but will be reviewed at the time based on pending medical factors and absolute necessity.***
- 6. In order to provide a socially-distanced environment, all our work stations will alternate systematically to prevent any close proximities between guests and team members.**
- 7. No same time service, all services must be done individually. *We will not encourage same time services (Ex: a manicure & pedicure at the same time). This is to minimize the amount of direct contact between individuals.***

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Guidelines from Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation / Texas Government Code

For the safety of our guests and our team members, we are also following the guidelines prescribed by TDLR and the Texas Government Code. We are 100% in compliance with every regulation and prescribe law. For a rule list of codes/regulations, please visit the respective websites as they are always updating and changing. We have outlined the major ones that our own policies haven't already covered. As a guest and team member, everyone is required to follow these procedures.

Failure to follow will result in refusal of service.

- 1. All such salons, shops, and establishments must ensure at least six feet of social distancing between operating work stations.**
- 2. Cosmetology salons and services are to operate at up to 25 percent of the total listed occupancy of the retail establishment.**
- 3. Stay home if you have had any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19.**
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Chills
 - Repeated shaking with chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Diarrhea
 - Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
 - Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19
- 4. Provide hand soap, alcohol-based hand sanitizers containing at least 60 percent alcohol, disinfectants, and disposable towels for licensees to clean their work surfaces.**

- 6. No extra people during your visit, the waiting area will be limited.**
